Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with the SEBI Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated 13th July, 2023 (“SEBI Circular”), we hereby submit disclosure regarding an Order passed by the Uttarakhand Pollution Control Board, Uttarakhand.

Details of the aforesaid Order, as required under the Listing Regulations and the SEBI Circular, is given below:

Nature and Details of the action(s) initiated or Order(s) passed	<p>The Company has received an assessment order form UKPCB ascertaining the final environmental compensation of Rs. 3,375,000 (Rupees Three Million Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand only) (“Assessment Order”) for its manufacturing plant located at IIE, SIIDCUL, Pantnagar.</p> <p>Background:</p> <p>1) This matter pertains to the <i>suo motu</i> action taken by the National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi (NGT) based on an article published in December 2018 in the newspaper “The Asian Age”.</p>

		<p>2) In the year 2019, NGT directed respective state pollution control boards to make an assessment of compensation to be recovered from the polluting industrial units for the last five years, taking into account the cost of restoration and the cost of damage to the public health and environment.</p> <p>3) In view of the above, in the year 2019, UKPCB had asked industries located at Integrated Industrial Estate (IIE) Rudrapur including the Company to deposit an interim environmental compensation of Rs. 10 million. However, the Hon'ble Supreme Court had granted a stay against such orders for <i>ad hoc</i> recover of compensation.</p> <p>4) In March 2023, the stay granted by Hon'ble Supreme Court was vacated. Hence, the Industries Association of SIIDCUL, Kumaun Garhwal Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and other industrial associations, where the Company is a member, had made representations to UKPCB and asked for the reassessment of compensation based on NGT guidelines. Accordingly, based on such representations made by the industrial associations on 5th April, 2023, UKPCB issued assessment order to the Company and other industrial units in IIE, Rudrapur.</p> <p>5) The Company has decided to make a payment of re-assessed environment compensation of Rs. 3,375,000 with the UKPCB based on the Assessment Order.</p>
